
PREPARATION:

Before class, print out the nurse hat template and copy onto white card stock for each child. Cut poster board into 1-inch strips. This makes the hatband. If you teach younger kids, glue the hat front to onto the hatband before class.

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

Have the children glue the nurse hat front to the hatband. Then color the nurse hat fronts and the hatband. Next, put on the stickers. Last, fit the hat to each child's head, and tape the band in place.

The kids should be familiar the American Red Cross Symbol. It is a symbol of taking care of people in need. Jesus tells us that we need to take care of others. That is why we use His cross instead of the American Red Cross on our nurse's hats.

LESSON 1: THE GOOD SAMARITAN ☆

Lessons in this series: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Overview

In this lesson, children discover Jesus is there to give them comfort whenever they need Him. They will also learn that they should provide help to others whenever they can.

TOPICS

Behavior, Caring, Friendship, Kindness, Neighborliness, Parables, Responsibility

AS KIDS ARRIVE (10 MINUTES)

As children arrive ask them to do small jobs such as picking up toys, straightening book shelves or drawing pictures to help make the classroom a more cheerful place. If they agree to help, let them know that they are being a good samaritan and that God sees their willingness to help.

BIBLE VERSE (5 MINUTES)

"Love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:39 NIV

Have the children repeat this verse several times. Then assign hand signs to represent each word. Have the children repeat the verse from memory using the hand signs.

BIBLE STORY (15 MINUTES)

Gather the children around you in preparation for story time. After the introduction, read the story about the Good Samaritan right from the Bible. If possible, use a Children's Bible so it will be easier for the kids to understand.

Introduction:

Jesus used stories to teach people about God. These stories are called parables. Many parables have been put into the Bible to help us learn about God too. Today we will hear a story about a man that needed his neighbors' help.

Read Luke 10:25-37 (The Good Samaritan)

Discussion Ouestions:

- 1. How did Jesus say we are to love our neighbors? (Just as we love ourselves.)
- 2. In our story today, why did two of the people pass by the man in need? (They put their needs, before the needs of the injured man. They had a selfish heart.)
- 3. Why did the Samaritan man stop and take the time to help the man in need? (He had a kind heart and saw that the other man was hurt and needed help.)
- 4. If you were hurt and needed assistance, what type of person would you want to help you? (A person like the Good Samaritan.)
- 5. What type of person does Jesus want us to be? (Jesus wants us to be like the Good Samaritan. We should help our neighbors.)


