

Your Profile

When you log in, access your Profile by **clicking on your Profile photo** in the top right corner.



Tip: If you don't know where to access your church's Church Community Builder portal, check their website for a "login" option or email your church staff.

When you click on your Profile photo, you'll be taken to your Profile. Here are the main areas of your Profile.



- Actions Button: This menu contains options to edit the following:
 - Communication Preferences: Change your communication preferences for emails you receive from the church.
 - Download Contact Card: Download a .vcf file of your Profile information.
 - My Fit: Edit your My Fit details.
 - Privacy: Update the visibility of your information to other people in the church.

- Username/Password: Edit your username or password for logging in.
- **Edit Profile button:** Update contact info, personal details and any custom information specific to attending your church.
- **Contact Info:** These are quick actions in order for other people to contact you.
 - o The **phone** appears if you have a phone number saved to your Profile.
 - The **envelope** appears if you have an email address saved in your Profile.
 - o The **location** pin appears if you have an address saved in your Profile.

Family Member's Profiles

Which Family Members can Edit Profiles?

- Primary Contact or Spouse: Can edit their own and any additional Family Members' Profiles.
- Child: Can edit their own Profile only.
- Other:Can edit their own Profile only.

Editing a Family Member's Profile

- 1. Go to the **About** tab in your Profile.
- 2. Hover over the name of the Family Member you want to view.
 - If you need to edit the information in a Family Member's Profile, click their name to open their Profile.
 - If you need to change their Family Position:
 - a. Hover over the person's name in the Family Tile.
